

OUR PROGRAMS

We offer three main programs designed to get children started on the path to successful, healthy, and happy lives. In each of these programs, Learning Together provides individualized services to meet the developmental, educational, and health needs of each child, while also providing support and training opportunities for families.

COMMUNITY PROGRAM

The Community Program offers Early Intervention services for children ages birth to 3 with developmental disabilities. Learning Together specifically works with children needing Developmental Therapy, a play therapy that assists children with their cognitive, language, fine and gross motor skills in addition to social skills.

Services are provided in the child's natural setting, to promote skill acquisition in the daily routines of the child and family. Services can take place in the home, daycare center, or even the grandparents' house. Children are seen anywhere from weekly to monthly depending on their needs.

With the assistance of Developmental Therapists, for nearly three decades, children have reached their developmental goals and milestones.

The Community Program is an approved provider agency and receives referrals from the Children's Developmental Services Agency.

DEVELOPMENTAL DAY CENTER

The Developmental Day Center was our first program established in 1969. We began as just a half day preschool program that included children with developmental disabilities. With over four decades of experience, we have grown to become an inclusive, five star Developmental Day center in downtown Raleigh that serves children 18 months to 5 years of age.

The Developmental Day Program serves children from all backgrounds, all socio-economic levels, and all abilities. Children with developmental disabilities ages 3 - 5 are served through a contract with Wake County Public Preschool Services. All of our classrooms are inclusive allowing children who are typically developing and children with special needs to interact, teach and learn from one another.

All classrooms are staffed with a licensed Birth - Kindergarten Lead Teacher and Teaching Assistants maintaining a 1:6 ratio maximum.

CHILD MENTAL HEALTH INITIATIVE

In January 2001, Learning Together began the Child Mental Health Initiative to provide comprehensive services to children birth to 8 years of age who have demonstrated serious social, emotional, behavioral, and /or mental health concerns that have jeopardized their child care, family life, and future growth and development. The program offers individualized and group treatment as well as parent counseling.

These services can take place in the child's home, childcare centers, in a clinical setting, or within the child's school classroom. Home-based therapy promotes parent training in floor time play therapy techniques and school-based therapy promotes social skills and frustration tolerance.

Parents who feel their child may need services can contact the program directly. Additional referrals for the program come from the Children's Developmental Services Agency, local nonprofits, social workers, and local health care providers.
