A corporate day of service is a unique opportunity for local businesses and organizations to become involved in their community! Here are some great ways that you and your coworkers can get involved at Learning Together!

These are just a few ideas. We can help customize your experience for your group!



★ **Fall Activity: Painting Pumpkins**
People: 2-20 Supplies: Small or big pumpkins to paint, paint/stickers and brushes, paper towels

★ **Winter Activity: Indoor Snow**
People: 2 - 20 Supplies: Baking soda, shaving cream, (optional: glitter, food coloring); Add vinegar to make a frozen volcano!

★ **Spring Activity: Egg Hunt**
People: 10 - 25 Supplies: plastic eggs filled with treats, bags, etc.

★ **Summer Activity: Field/Carnival Day**
People: 20 -50 Supplies: Face Painting Supplies, Carnival game activities, bean bag toss, etc.

★ **Sensory Activity: Portable Aquarium**
People: 2 -20 Supplies: Hair gel, sandwich bags, food coloring, foam fish/sea creatures, packing tape (to seal bags)

★ **Sensory Activity: Start a Band**
People: 2 - 20 Supplies: Art and craft supplies to make noisemakers/drums, individual who can play real instruments

★ **Playgrounds, Classrooms & Cafeteria Clean-Up**
People: 5-20 Supplies: Cleaning cloths, cleaning solution, cleaning gloves, rakes, trash bags

★ **Help a Teacher!**
People: 2 - 40 Supplies: Willingness to help with laminating, copying, cutting, inventory, or whatever other tasks our teachers need
