On Sunday, June 26 at around 11:00am, there was a gas leak in the Crosby-Garfield Building resulting in an explosion and fire that has made the building unsafe. As a result, Learning Together has temporarily closed through at least July 8. We are grateful that no one was present in the building, and no one was harmed. The health and safety of our children and staff are always our utmost priorities.

This significantly impacts our community, and especially our families and staff. Learning Together leadership is doing everything possible to address the situation, continue services to our families, and create a plan for teachers and staff. Your patience and understanding is deeply appreciated.

We are now and will continue to be in conversations with Wake County and City of Raleigh officials, Childcare Licensing Consultants and area community organizations in hopes of reopening soon in an alternative space. This is a quickly evolving and emotional situation, and we appreciate your support at this time.
